Day 1: Wednesday, October 16, 2024 Buffalo, New York - Niagara Falls - Tour Begins Let's go, Buffalo! Arrive at the Buffalo International Airport before heading to Niagara Falls — your home for the next three nights.

Day 2: Thursday, October 17, 2024 Niagara Falls Today, you're taking to the water and heading to the US side of Niagara Falls. Head to Lockport for a cruise on the historic Erie Canal. With 35 locks, this canal dates back to the 1800s. It was created to connect the Hudson and Niagara Rivers, allowing for large vessels to travel across New York state via water. After your canal cruise, enjoy lunch before your visit to another famed body of water: Niagara Falls. (B, L)

Day 3: Friday, October 18, 2024 Niagara Falls, Canada Get your passport ready! Today, cross the border into Canada to see the mighty Niagara Falls up close on your Maid of the Mist cruise. After, get acquainted with the charming town of Niagara-on-the-Lake, nestled along the shores of Lake Ontario and the Niagara River. Explore its Heritage District, which has a distinctly old-fashioned atmosphere -perhaps visit an antique store or a cheese shop. See vineyards and wineries, boutiques, art galleries, the centuries-old courthouse, and theatres. This town, which was the original capital of Upper Canada from 1792 to 1797, has something for everyone. Meander its streets and uncover its charm in your own way. This evening, before returning to your hotel, enjoy dinner with a fabulous view. (*B*, *D*)

Day 4: Saturday, October 19, 2024 Niagara Falls, New York - Cooperstown *Guten tag*, Canandaigua and hello Sonnenberg Gardens and Mansion. "Sonnenberg," German for "sunny hill," plays home to nine formal gardens and 40-room Queen Anne-style mansion. This time of year, Asters, chrysanthemums, and some other seasonal flowers will dot the landscape. Depart the Finger Lakes and continue your journey to the charming Central New York village of Cooperstown for the next two nights. (B, D)

Day 5: Sunday, October 20, 2024 Cooperstown Step through MLB history because today, you'll visit the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum. Take a look at artifacts like Babe Ruth's famous Yankees uniform or iconic home run bats. Stroll through the bronze Plaque Gallery highlighting history's most notable ball players. The afternoon is yours to enjoy Cooperstown. Consider visiting other nearby institutions like the Farmer's Museum or the Fenimore Art Museum, or popping into the quaint, tiny Cooperstown Diner for a bite. *(B)*

Day 6: Monday, October 21, 2024 Cooperstown - West Point - New York City Following the route of the Hudson River, trek south today to the home of the United States Military Academy, West Point. Learn about the prestigious academy's history, dating back to the early 1800s. After stopping for lunch at the West Point Club, continue to New York City, "the city that never sleeps." (*B, L*)

Day 7: Tuesday, October 22, 2024 New York City Start your day with a fun-filled breakfast at the famous Ellen's Stardust Diner, a 50s-themed restaurant featuring a singing wait staff. After breakfast embrace the energy of this fascinating city on a locally guided tour of the "Big Apple." You'll see Greenwich Village, the Wall Street district, Little Italy, Chinatown, Central Park, and other time-honored landmarks. Enjoy the afternoon at your leisure. Say farewell to this extraordinary city as we enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 8: Wednesday, October 23, 2024 New York City - Tour Ends Your journey through the Empire State comes to a close today. (B)

Book Now rates valid until Apr 16, 2024, valid on air inclusive packages only. The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. IDENTIFICATION

Travel within USA

For travel completed by May 6, 2025, all airlines will ask for identification when you check in. It is recommended that you carry a passport if you have one. A driver's license (with a photo I.D.) is also acceptable for domestic flights.

Effective for travel May 7, 2025 forward, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while travelling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States. Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees associated with changing a reservation resulting from a non-compliant identification will be the responsibility of the guest. 
Experience It! Niagara Falls

While referred to as one unit, Niagara actually consists of three distinct falls – Horseshoe Falls, American Falls, and Bridal Veil Falls. It's said that 3,160 tons of water flow over the falls every second, traveling at a steady rate of 25 mph. Stand in awe and quiet admiration of this natural wonder.
