**Day 1: Friday, May 9, 2025 Overnight Flight** It is time to explore the Istrian peninsula and Croatia's islands on the northern Adriatic including the magic of Venice. Medieval architecture, sunny islands, and a private small cruise ship await you in Croatia. From stunning coastlines, charming Istrian peninsula and nature parks, to culinary delicacies, art and history to romantic Venice, the wonders of the northern Adriatic are yours to explore.

**Day 2: Saturday, May 10, 2025 Split, Croatia - Šibenik - Embark Ship - Tour Begins** Welcome to Croatia! Upon arrival in Split transfer to Šibenik, where the Krka River flows into the Adriatic Sea. Explore the city's historical center on a locally-guided walking tour past medieval alleys, well-preserved fortresses, and the Cathedral of St. James, a stunning domed Catholic basilica and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later this afternoon, board your ship and settle into your home for the next 7 nights. This evening meet your fellow travelers at a welcome dinner accompanied by traditional Klapa singing, a form of a cappella. With a glass of champagne, toast to the beginning of your adventure! (D)

**Day 3: Sunday, May 11, 2025 Šibenik - Kornati National Park - Vodice - Telašćica** Enjoy a leisurely breakfast onboard this morning or you may choose to disembark early for an optional morning tour to the breathtaking Krka National Park. \* If you stay onboard, do not miss the unforgettable sights as you sail through St. Anthony's channel and pass by tiny islands and St. Nicola's fortress (UNESCO). This is one of the best-preserved works of defense, and unique monument of the world's architectural heritage. As you sail to Vodice where you will have time to explore independently. This afternoon soak in one of the most beautiful parts of your cruise as you travel through the Kornati National Park. Made up of 140 islands, islets and reefs, the Kornati Archipelago's tranquil waters are lined with stunningly beautiful rugged terrain and abundant wildlife. Continue your travels toward Telašćica. This evening, enjoy the festive Captain's Dinner. (B, L, D)

**Day 4: Monday, May 12, 2025 Telašćica Nature Park - Zadar** As you cruise toward the Zadar Islands this morning, convene with nature and enjoy the opportunity to sun, swim and get an up-close look at the unrivaled beauty of Telašćica Nature Park on Telašćica Bay. Arrive this afternoon in Zadar and explore this fascinating city's irresistible blend of old and new during a guided tour. Roman ruins dating back to the 1st century, Byzantine architecture of the 9th century, and the magnificent Cathedral of St. Anastasia speak to Zadar's rich history, while exciting modern art installations on the seafront engage you in the present. Listen to the mystical warbling of the *Sea Organ*, whose sound comes from ocean water rushing through tubes below marble steps and witness the art installation *Greeting to the Sun*, creating beautiful evening light shows powered by the day's sunshine for experiences that could only happen in Zadar. This evening is at leisure for you to stroll Zadar's streets, perhaps sampling Dalmatian cuisine during dinner at a local café or indulging in one of the many gelato shops. (B, L)

**Day 5: Tuesday, May 13, 2025 Zadar - Rab** Pass picturesque Pag, Olib, and many of the other smaller islands of the Zadar Archipelago on your way to the narrow island of Rab this afternoon. An included tour of Rab, which is enclosed by ancient stone walls, highlights the four majestic church towers that welcome visitors to its old town, the beautiful park that winds around wooded hills to the beaches, and the large collection of sacral art at the Franciscan Monastery of St. Bernardino. This evening, a pastry chef will show you how to make a Croatian delicacy local to the island: Rab cake. Bite into this delectable almond spiral while you sip on a gin and tonic made with locally-made gin. The night is yours to explore Rab your way. (B, L)

**Day 6: Wednesday, May 14, 2025 Rab - Krk** Today, sail to the largest island in the Adriatic: Krk. During a guided tour of Krk Town, learn about the long history and rich cultural heritage still reflected in

the present day town. See the 5th-century Krk Cathedral, dating back to the island's time under Roman rule and the 12th-century Frankopan Castle built by Croatian noble people. Each well-preserved wall, cathedral, temple, square and monument reflects a different part of the islands' story and there is a piece of history underfoot with each step you take. After exploring Krk, return to your ship and enjoy dinner. (B, L, D)

**Day 7: Thursday, May 15, 2025 Krk - Cres** Take advantage of a morning at leisure to spend more time exploring Krk Town or take a swim in the crystal blue waters of the Adriatic. Or, perhaps you will join an optional tour to get a taste of the regions past with visits to the Kornic Ethnographic collection, the traditional coastal village of Punat and a boat trip to the tiny natural wonder of Košljun Island. This afternoon depart Krk and let the open, pristine waters of the Adriatic bring you to the colorful island of Cres, a lovely port town where the streets are lined by yellow, cream, tan, and brown terraced houses dotted with blue awnings and umbrellas. A city tour takes you through homes winding into a maze, which draw you to the center of Cres' Old Town. Medieval architecture harkens back to simpler times when the island was simply a fisherman's paradise. Relish an evening

at leisure to take in the coast, culture and charm of Cres independently. (B, L)

**Day 8: Friday, May 16, 2025 Cres - Opatija** Today, it's off to Opatija! Enjoy a morning cruise through the Istrian Peninsula with time along the way for a swim and lunch before arriving at Opatija. Join your Tour Manager on an orientation walk and later enjoy free time to explore this coastal paradise and dinner on your own in one of its many trendy restaurants this evening. (B, L)

**Day 9: Saturday, May 17, 2025 Opatija - Disembark Ship - Rijeka** Bid farewell to your ship when you disembark in Opatija. **Day 10: Sunday, May 18, 2025 Rijeka - Hum - Motovun - Rijeka**

After breakfast, take time to enjoy beautiful beaches and the coastline of the Adriatic Sea. Later, set off to discover Hum, situated on one of the numerous hilltops in Istria, and the smallest town in the world! Enjoy the Istrian countryside and landscapes at an olive farm known to be one of the best producers in the Istrian Peninsula, learn the process of producing olive oil and local flavors when you sample this aromatic culinary staple. A true farm-to-table dinner at a local restaurant in the hills of Motovun allows you to end your day sampling regional wines and classic Istrian delicacies. (B, D)

**Day 11: Monday, May 19, 2025 Rijeka - Venice** This morning, say “dovidenja” to Croatia, as you continue your journey towards Venice. Along the way, experience the Italian region of *Collio*. Tucked in the northeast corner of Italy and covered with sunny hills and slopes, this region is home to some of the world’s best, unique white wines. Pause for lunch in a family-owned winery before heading onto Venice. Among the most romantic cities in the world, Venice welcomes you with its 117 tiny islands surrounded by a latticework of 150 canals and 400 bridges. (B, L)

**Day 12: Tuesday, May 20, 2025 Venice - Murano Island** This morning, travel by boat to Murano Island for an expert glass-blowing demonstration – a centuries-long tradition on the island. Then, join your local guide for a walking tour of Venice’s most iconic sights. Pause for a perfect view over the Bridge of Sighs and take in St. Mark’s Square, adorned with marbled palaces and gilded basilicas. The rest of the day is yours to explore. This evening toast to this memorable voyage during a farewell dinner with your fellow travelers. (B, D)

**Day 13: Wednesday, May 21, 2025 Venice - Tour Ends** Say “ciao” to Italy and the Croatian islands as your tour ends today. (B)

**Book Now rates valid until Apr 10, 2024, valid on air inclusive packages only.** The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you’re an on-the-go traveler. You don’t want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn’t a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour. Order of sightseeing on board the ship may vary based on departure and weather conditions and is at the sole discretion of the cruise line.

### Krk

#### **Krk Island Tour featuring Kornic Ethnographic Collection, Punat, and Košljun Isl \$65 USD**

Enjoy a morning tour of the quaint Kornic Ethnographic Collection, where you will tour a two-story family house. Complete with antique furniture, utensils, and tools, the home reflects a bygone era where family members farmed, cooked, cleaned, sewed, and performed all housekeeping duties by hand. You will then travel to Punat, a village located in a serene and well-protected bay that has served as a safe-haven for ships, fishermen, and sailors for centuries. It is also home to the oldest and largest marina on the Adriatic Sea. From Punat, you'll embark on a taxi-boat and head to the small, but beautiful, island Košljun — an island covered by dense forest and over 400 different species of mushrooms. The centerpiece of our visit to Košljun is the pristine fifteenth-century Franciscan monastery. Inside, a dazzling collection of folk costumes and rare Glagolitic manuscripts awaits. *Duration: Approximately 3 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

### Sibenik

#### **Krka National Park Tour \$75 USD**

This guided tour takes you through 2 square kilometers of the blue-green splendor of Krka National Park, a 109-square kilometer paradise along the Krka River. At the river banks, you can get an up-close look at several perfectly preserved ecosystems including a vast floral composition along the Tufa waterfalls. A highlight of this excursion is a revitalizing round-trip walk along the river's longest waterfall, Skradinski Buk - one of the best-known natural beauties of Croatia that is best seen at the end of the walk. Krka National Park is home to the first European hydroelectric power plant – a now historical site – and provided the first source of electricity to the city of Sibenik, thanks to Nikola Tesla. During your guided tour, you'll also visit the Ethnic Village where inside you'll find a traditional folk village complete with mills, souvenir shops, and ethnographic exhibition venues. Your time in Krka National Park will end with a scenic boat ride along the river to Skradin, where the Krka River meets with the Adriatic Sea. The coach will then bring you back to your cruise ship. This tour operates on a weather-permitting basis. *Duration: Approximately 3.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

#### Day 4: Dubrovnik

Enjoy another day at leisure in this "Pearl of the Adriatic". Whether you choose to relax at a beautiful beach and take a dip in crystal-blue waters or to continue exploring Dubrovnik streets, savor your last full day here. *Today breakfast will be included.*
