ITINERARY AT A GLANCE

Days 1 – 6 Sheraton New York Times Square, New York, New York

On some dates alternate hotels may be used.

Day 1: Thursday, September 17, 2026 New York City, New York “Start spreading the news,” because today you arrive in America’s most exciting metropolis for a getaway filled with shopping, sightseeing and endless entertainment. Relax as you enjoy a single-hotel stay in the heart of the city. There are no included activities today.

Day 2: Friday, September 18, 2026 New York City An exciting day begins with breakfast at a local eatery, before embracing the city’s energy on a locally guided tour of the “Big Apple.” Find yourself in Greenwich Village, the Wall Street district, Chinatown, and Central Park. See the Empire State Building and many other time-honored landmarks. Take advantage of some free time this afternoon to discover the city at your own pace. Your Tour Manager has countless suggestions on how to spend your time. Maybe you are up for a shopping spree at some of the world’s most legendary department stores, including Macy’s, Bloomingdale’s and Saks Fifth Avenue. Later, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. Then, take your seat at a Broadway show! (B, D)

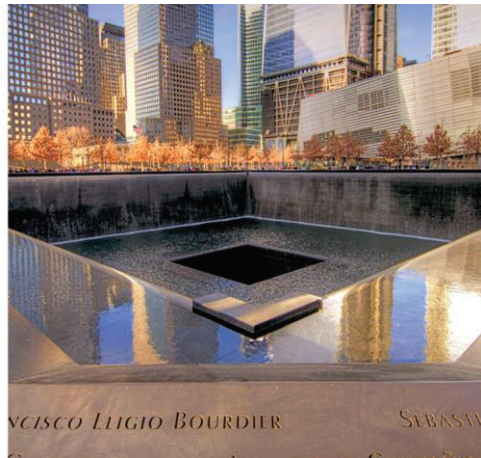
Day 3: Saturday, September 19, 2026 New York City Enjoy breakfast at a local diner, then, board a ferry for a cruise of New York Harbor. Take in the incredible views of the towering Statue of Liberty. Dock and get up-close to “Lady Liberty.” She has welcomed immigrants and visitors to New York Harbor since 1886. Created as a token of friendship between the U.S. and France, the Statue of Liberty has become a global symbol of freedom. Then it’s on to Ellis Island. Step back in time on a self-guided tour of the museum. Come to know the personal stories of the immigration boom of 1892-1924 when 12 million people passed through this station on their journey to America. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore “the city that never sleeps.” Tonight, choose to join an optional walking tour of Greenwich Village including dinner. (B)

Day 4: Sunday, September 20, 2026 New York City This morning, drive through the Wall Street district on your way to downtown, reflect at the 9/11 Memorial and take a self-guided tour at the 9/11 Museum - two poignant tributes to the lives lost. This afternoon, the curtains rise for your second Broadway show. You’ll choose from a selection of Broadway’s biggest hits.* Later, gather for another night out in the city for dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: Monday, September 21, 2026 New York City - Brooklyn This morning, begin a Brooklyn adventure by heading downtown to walk across the Brooklyn Bridge. Just over a mile long, this impressive structure is pedestrian-friendly with separate driving and walking levels. Look out from the bridge in awe of the skyscrapers and Statue of Liberty as you leave Manhattan behind and enter a new borough. Next, step inside the Brooklyn Seltzer Museum, a space dedicated to the iconic Brooklyn Seltzer Boys, where you’ll learn all about seltzer, its origins, and the legendary “seltzer men” who still deliver to homes all around Brooklyn today. Transfer to Brooklyn’s trendy, waterfront DUMBO neighborhood and explore Bridge Park with free time for lunch. Maybe you’ll try some famous Brooklyn pizza. Return to your Times Square hotel with the remainder of the day at leisure. (B)

Day 6: Tuesday, September 22, 2026 New York City Today, the morning and afternoon are yours to explore the city. Visit a museum, take a walk in the park, go souvenir shopping, try a new restaurant — the possibilities are endless! Then, gather for dinner this evening and toast to the end of your “Big Apple” journey. (B, D)

Day 7: Wednesday, September 23, 2026 New York City - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close with many memories of fabulous New York, New York.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Walking to our dinner restaurants may require up to 0.75 miles each way.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

*For the matinee Broadway performance, travelers will be provided with a selection of shows to choose from. Selection of shows is subject to change based upon availability. Actual shows available for choices will be advised approximately 80 days prior to departure and must be finalized at 50 days

prior to departure. Day of the Broadway show and performance selections are subject to change. Once travelers choose show of preference, changes are not permitted. Some Broadway performances may not be suitable for children; please inquire at time of reservation.

When reserving a triple room, please note that it will have two double beds. Due to fire safety regulations, a rollaway bed cannot be brought into the room.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Experience It! Broadway

Broadway, New York City's theater district, runs from 41st Street to 53rd Street between Sixth and Ninth Avenues. The first theater was built in 1798 and over the years, the district has grown to 40 theaters that are now considered "on Broadway." In 1927, the street was nicknamed the "Great White Way" due to the bright white lights that illuminated the streets and advertised the multitude of shows. During this period, the shows were mostly comedies and operettas, and some vaudeville. Many of the Broadway shows that we know today were developed in the 1940s. Rodgers and Hammerstein were the pioneers who first combined song, dance, comedy and drama to create the modern musical. The lights are still shining bright, theater attendance is thriving, and to be "on Broadway" is now the most highly respected achievement for theater professionals.
