Day 1: Thursday, March 11, 2027 Overnight Flight Your adventure through Africa begins! Incredible landscapes lead the way to a blend of cultural diversity, an abundance of wildlife, and remarkable history. From urban centers to untamed wilderness, this transcontinental African journey invites you to discover its soul-stirring spirit and awe-inspiring wonders.

Day 2: Friday, March 12, 2027 Johannesburg, South Africa Welcome to Johannesburg, South Africa's vibrant gateway city. After your long international flights, today is all about rest and recovery. With your hotel conveniently located near the airport, this evening is designed as a quiet pause before the adventure begins. There are no scheduled activities today, allowing you to settle in at your own pace. While the city center is accessible for those who wish to explore, we recommend taking this time to relax and adjust to the new time zone.

Day 3: Saturday, March 13, 2027 Johannesburg - Kruger National Park Leave the city behind and start your adventure with a six-hour overland drive into the wild as you head to Kruger National Park — South Africa's largest game reserve. See how the landscape shifts dramatically, giving you a glimpse of the expansive savannas and diverse ecosystems that make Kruger so unique. Your lodge, positioned at the park's entrance, sets the stage for your safari experience. Tonight, gather with fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (B, D)

Day 4: Sunday, March 14, 2027 Kruger National Park Get your camera ready — today is all about the wildlife! Set out on a full-day game drive in an open-air vehicle, searching for Africa's iconic "Big 5" — the safari "bucket list" of animals includes lions, leopards, rhinos, elephants, and buffalos. Pause midday for a picnic lunch, then continue your safari adventure into the afternoon. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Monday, March 15, 2027 Kruger National Park This morning in Kruger National Park, **it's your choice!** Rise early for a sunrise safari to watch the landscape awaken **-OR-** or enjoy a slower start and head out later for an afternoon game drive. However you explore, the magic of Kruger surrounds you. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Tuesday, March 16, 2027 Kruger National Park - Cape Town Wave goodbye to the wilderness and fly south to Cape Town, South Africa's electric cultural mecca. Nestled between mountains and sea, the "Mother City" invites you to explore its vibrant neighborhoods, historic sites, and scenic waterfront. Settle in for your three-night stay. (B)

Day 7: Wednesday, March 17, 2027 Cape Town Start your day with a ride up Table Mountain* by cable car, where panoramic views stretch from Lion's Head to Robben Island. Then, dive into Cape Town's rich history on a guided city tour including a drive past the colorful Bo-Kaap and a walk through The Company's Garden in the center of the city. Your tour will end early afternoon, allowing time for lunch at a location of your choice and a free afternoon. Then, travel to a home of a Capetonian family where you're an honored guest. Over dinner, exchange stories and get to know what everyday life is like in Cape Town. (B, D)

Day 8: Thursday, March 18, 2027 Cape Town Venture along the Western Cape, stopping at the legendary Cape of Good Hope, where dramatic cliffs meet the crashing sea. Take a funicular to the top of Cape Point and hike up sandstone steps to the lighthouse that protects wayward ships from an unfortunate demise. Enjoy lunch overlooking the ocean before heading to Boulders Beach to see the protected colony of endangered African penguins. (B, L)

Day 9: Friday, March 19, 2027 Cape Town - Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe Fly to one of the world's most awe-inspiring natural wonders — Victoria Falls. Settle in at your lodge overlooking Zambezi National Park. (B, D)

Day 10: Saturday, March 20, 2027 Victoria Falls Feel the mist on your face as you stand before the mighty Victoria Falls — a thundering cascade that stirs the soul. After a free afternoon, unwind with a sunset cruise along the Zambezi River. (B)

Day 11: Sunday, March 21, 2027 Victoria Falls This morning, experience an **Impact Moment** as you connect with conservation efforts during a visit to the Victoria Falls Wildlife Trust. After, travel into Chinotimba township and market — a bustling hub and great place to shop for some African curios to take back home. (B, L)

Day 12: Monday, March 22, 2027 Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe - Nairobi, Kenya This morning, you might opt to join a responsibly organized wildlife viewing with African elephants in their natural habitat as you learn about them from their handlers. Later this afternoon, fly to Nairobi, the capital city of Kenya and your gateway to East Africa's wonders. (B, L)

Day 13: Tuesday, March 23, 2027 Nairobi - Maasai Mara National Reserve Depart Nairobi early this morning and begin your journey in specially designed 4x4 safari vehicles into the Maasai Mara, one of Kenya's best spots for wildlife viewing. Traverse through ever-changing landscapes along roads that can be bumpy and dusty at times — it all adds to the adventure! Settle into your tented safari camp — a truly special experience that brings you closer to nature. You won't sacrifice comfort in these unique semi-permanent tents complete with plush bedding and en-suite facilities. This afternoon, head out on your first game drive and witness the Mara's incredible biodiversity. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Wednesday, March 24, 2027 Maasai Mara National Reserve Today, go deeper into the wild with a morning and afternoon game drive. As you explore the Mara's open grasslands and rolling plains, you'll have the chance to see large herds of antelope and wildebeest that thrive in this unique ecosystem. Keep your eyes peeled for the "Big 5" and enjoy a picnic lunch on the open plains, surrounded by zebras, scattered acacia trees, and the rhythm of the savanna. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Thursday, March 25, 2027 Maasai Mara National Reserve By now, you've become an expert at spotting wildlife! After breakfast, depart on an early morning game drive, returning to camp mid-morning. Perhaps you'll spend some time in one of the camp's treehouses, spotting giraffes in the distance or admiring the many bird species that thrive here. Later, head out on an afternoon game drive, returning to camp as the sun sets. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Friday, March 26, 2027 Maasai Mara National Reserve - Nairobi Return to Nairobi and step into the world of *Out of Africa* with a visit to Karen Blixen's farmhouse. Enjoy a free evening to relax. (B, L)

Day 17: Saturday, March 27, 2027 Nairobi - Cairo, Egypt Pre-dawn this morning,** say goodbye to your African Tour Manager before boarding your five-hour flight to Cairo, Egypt. Arrive in the "Land of the Pharaohs" and meet your Egyptian Tour Manager, who will accompany you for the rest of the trip. Feel Cairo's constant thrum of energy wrap around you as you arrive to your hotel for a two-night stay. Take the rest of the day to relax and catch up on sleep after the red-eye flight. This evening, gather for your first taste of Egyptian cuisine at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 18: Sunday, March 28, 2027 Cairo Be prepared for a dose of Cairo's legendary traffic as you head to Giza this morning. Today, stand in awe before the Pyramids of Giza and the enigmatic Great Sphinx - timeless icons of human achievement. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon and enjoy a free evening. (B, L)

Day 19: Monday, March 29, 2027 Cairo - Luxor - Board Ship Rise before dawn*** for your 75-minute flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, visit the expansive Karnak Temple - a sprawling 4,000-year-old complex of towering pylons and intricate obelisks. Then, board your Nile River cruise ship and settle in for your four-night voyage. After lunch on board, enjoy a leisurely afternoon to explore the ship. This evening, take in golden hour views from the sundeck before gathering for your first dinner aboard. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Tuesday, March 30, 2027 Luxor - Valley of the Kings - Edfu As dawn breaks, venture to Luxor's West Bank, trekking along the elaborate tombs of the Valley of the Kings.**** Delve even further into Egyptian legends with an included viewing of the tombs of King Tutankhamun and Ramses VI. Visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut as well as the Colossi of Memnon before returning to the ship for a late lunch. In the early afternoon, set sail to Edfu, where you'll arrive early tomorrow morning. As you sail upstream, glimpse the small farms scattered along the Nile's banks, and appreciate the simple, modest livings of local farmers. (B, L, D)

Day 21: Wednesday, March 31, 2027 Edfu - Kom Ombo In Edfu, pick between an early or a late start to your day, because **it's your choice!** Head out at daybreak for a guided visit of the mesmerizing Temple of Horus, returning for a late breakfast aboard **-OR-** rise at your leisure and linger over a relaxed breakfast, as you take in views of a place where daily life has changed little over the centuries. This afternoon, coast along to Kom Ombo and visit a rare double temple. Then, watch the Egyptian landscape slowly drift by as you sail on to Aswan. This evening, don a traditional Egyptian gown and join a festive galabeya party for a fun evening on board. (B, L, D)

Day 22: Thursday, April 1, 2027 Aswan Your morning opens in Aswan, the Nubian city. Discover the mysteries of Philae Temple. Located on a small island, this complex can only be reached by motorboat. Philae is among the architectural wonders rescued from the rising waters of the Nile during the construction of the High Dam. The afternoon is yours to explore more of Aswan. Perhaps you'll visit the fascinating

artifacts at the Nubian Archeological Museum. This evening, aboard a *felucca* (wooden sailboat), take in the views of the tall sand dunes on the western shore of the Nile before relaxing over dinner aboard. (B, L, D)

Day 23: Friday, April 2, 2027 Disembark Ship - Fly to Cairo Early this morning,**** return to Cairo with a 90-minute flight. Upon arrival, head towards the old town and enjoy some free time to shop in the world-famous Khan el-Khalili bazaar. Peruse colorful trinkets, hand-painted crafts, polished pendants, and more. This afternoon, check into your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure. (B)

Day 24: Saturday, April 3, 2027 Cairo This morning, get a glimpse into ancient Egypt's pharaohs, power struggles, and dynasties during a visit to the recently inaugurated Grand Egyptian Museum. This world-class landmark showcases over 100,000 ancient artifacts, including the treasures discovered in 1922 in King Tutankhamun's sepulcher. Tonight, toast to the memories made on this epic journey through Africa at a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 25: Sunday, April 4, 2027 Cairo - Tour Ends Your adventure in Africa ends today. Return home with a heart full of stories and a deeper connection to this extraordinary continent. (B)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until Aug 31, 2026, valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 19 people (maximum of 24).

For the safety and well-being of our travelers, children under the age of 13 will not be allowed to join us on this tour. Contact us with any questions at time of booking.

****Visiting the Valley of the Kings requires walking on sand and mostly unpaved paths. In addition, visiting the tombs requires navigating through multiple steep staircases and/or ramps with limited help from handrails.

During your visit of the Pyramids of Giza you will have some free time in the area of the Great Pyramid of Pharaoh Cheops (Khufu) and you may wish to visit its interior. The visit requires agility as you will have to climb up steep, narrow steps (approximately 1-1 1/2 feet/35-50 centimeters tall) on the side of the Pyramid without the help of handrails. From there, you may access the inner chamber and will need to crouch and, at times, crawl up the 300-foot (100-meter) narrow shaft with minimal help from handrails. This activity is usually not suitable for people suffering from claustrophobia.

In Egypt, your itinerary includes many activities that require walking and standing for extended periods of time on uneven terrain and sand. There are very few places to stop and sit (no benches). Most of the sightseeing takes place in areas where there is NO shade, therefore you will be walking and standing for extended periods under direct, extraordinarily strong sunlight. Visiting tombs, temples and pyramids requires climbing and descending steep staircases and/or ramps with limited or no help from

handrails. Some of these visits may not be suitable for people suffering from claustrophobia.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

The included activities are not suitable for travelers using motorized scooters, wheelchairs, walkers, or Zimmer-frames.

Temperatures can easily exceed 105° F (40.5° C), particularly in Petra, the Dead Sea, Aswan, and Luxor. Be sure to bring adequate sun protection.

Maximum Elevation: 7800 feet / 2377 meters.

Your program includes many early-morning departures. While in Egypt, you should expect to depart your hotel or ship sometime between 3:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. to transfer to the airport for your internal flights. On days visiting Giza, the Valley of the Kings and Edfu, you should expect early morning departures between 5:30 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. to ensure you profit from the cooler hours of the day and reach the sites ahead of the larger crowds.

There will be 3 long transfer days by coach, each lasting at approximately 6 hours, including stops. Some roads in South Africa, Zimbabwe, and Kenya can be rugged and unpredictable — often consisting of dirt or gravel tracks that are significantly rougher and bumpier than you may be accustomed to. Expect uneven terrain, dust, and some long days of driving on this tour. We employ experienced drivers who know how to handle these conditions, and every effort will be made to ensure your comfort.

There is an additional cost to enter inside the Great Pyramid of Giza and special tombs in the Valley of the Kings. We cover the entrance fee to many sites and to some special tombs (King Tutankhamun and King Ramses VI tombs in the Valley of the Kings), but other special tombs/sites will be at your expense. Rates are subject to change at any time based on governing authority. Your Egyptian Tour Manager will facilitate the onsite purchase of these tickets by collecting the fees at the beginning of the tour day.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour. Order of sightseeing on board the ship may vary based on departure and weather conditions and is at the sole discretion of the cruise line.

Wildlife sightings cannot be guaranteed.

*Table Mountain Cableway is subject to change and availability due to weather conditions.

Personal audio devices (headsets) are included in Egypt only.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by observance of religious or local holidays such as Ramadan and Eid. If traveling during the month of Ramadan, please note that the order of some features will vary and that some meal experiences may be replaced with meals in the hotel instead of local restaurants/venues. Some shops on the street may also be closed. Traveling during Ramadan also offers a unique chance to immerse yourself in local culture, witness spiritual traditions, bond with communities during iftars, explore diverse cuisine, enjoy quiet serenity, and experience hospitality and generosity from locals. Ramadan observances are from February 7-March 8, 2027. Eid al-Fitr will take place March 9-11, 2027.

Personal Use Photography / Videography: Visitors can take photos and videos for personal use using non-professional phones, digital cameras, or camcorders in most archaeological sites and museums. To preserve the artifacts and artwork, flash photography is forbidden in most museums and indoor archeological sites. Your Tour Manager will inform you about the local regulations while on tour.

Access to the interior of the Great Pyramid requires a separate ticket, for an additional cost of approximately \$40 US Dollars. The ticket can only be purchased on site and your Egyptian Tour Manager will assist you with this request.

Nile cruise ships commonly dock side-by-side, sometimes several vessels across, due to limited port space. While moored, you will need to pass through other ships using connecting gangways to reach the dock. Cabin views will be obstructed or receive limited natural light during these periods. This is a normal part of the Nile cruising experience and should be expected regardless of ship category. Scenic views of the Nile are best enjoyed while sailing or from the sun deck when the vessel is underway.

Single accommodations are extremely limited. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple and child accommodations are not available.

Specially-adapted 4x4 safari vehicles are used while in Maasai Mara. These are designed for the terrain and to maximize game-viewing opportunities. They are not air-conditioned and do not have toilets. Frequent stops are made during travel periods.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

**The exact flight schedule will be confirmed closer to departure. Due to limited flights, your flight from Nairobi to Cairo may take off as early as 4:20 a.m., requiring a 2:00 a.m. departure from the hotel.

***The exact flight schedule will be confirmed closer to departure. Due to limited flights, your flight from Cairo to Luxor may take off as early as 5:30 a.m., requiring a 2:30 a.m. departure from the hotel.

****The exact flight schedule will be confirmed closer to departure. Due to limited flights, your flight from Aswan to Cairo may take off as early as 6:00 a.m., requiring a 3:30 a.m. departure from the ship.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

If traveling internationally with a child under the age of 18, please check directly with the airline for the legal documentation that is required. It is the sole responsibility of the traveler to procure the proper documentation to travel, and many requirements vary by airline and destination.

We will not be responsible for costs incurred for missed flights or canceled tours where a traveler fails to secure proper documentation.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Park fees starting from \$1000 USD per person (subject to change without advance notice), quoted at time of booking, are payable at time of final payment.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports and visas are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require a minimum of 6 months passport validity from date of return home. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that our travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

A valid single entry visa is required for Zimbabwe. Single entry visa cost is approximately \$30 USD for US, Australian and New Zealand citizens and \$75 USD for Canadian citizens. The visa may be purchased upon arrival, in cash only. Payments at Ports of Entry for visa **must** be made in USD. The visa may also be applied for online through the following website: www.evisa.gov.zw Rates are approximate and can be changed at any time based on governing authority.

An Egyptian visa is required for this tour. The Egyptian visa is obtained upon arrival in Egypt and is purchased prior to getting in line for immigration. Our local representative will assist in securing it and will collect \$30 US Dollars at that time. Rates are subject to change at any time based on governing authority.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

An eTA (Electronic Travel Authority) for Kenya is required for this tour at your own expense. Travelers are required to apply for an eTA prior to arriving in Kenya through the following website: www.etakenya.go.ke. You can apply for the eTA up to three months in advance but no less than three days prior to departure for an approximate fee of \$30 US Dollars, excluding a handling fee and credit card fee. Rates are approximate and can be changed at any time based on governing authority. An accommodation booking confirmation is required as supporting documentation for the eTA. Your Collette itinerary can be used as this confirmation.

Each traveler is responsible for proper documentation and inoculations that may be required and/or recommended to participate on this tour. Please contact your local travel clinic or personal physician for specific details on the destinations you are traveling to and from.

Upon departure from Kenya, you will need a Yellow Fever certificate to enter Egypt.

Please be aware that if your flight schedule is via Dubai or if you are stopping over in Dubai and are carrying narcotic drugs, controlled or semi-controlled drugs, then you will be required to complete an electronic form prior to entering the country, to obtain approval to carry medication. Please use the link <https://mohap.gov.ae/en/w/approve-emergency-drugs-and-psychoactive-materials> to view the guidelines. A user's guide is available to explain the application and the supporting documents required. For regular prescription or over-the-counter medication, no prior approval is necessary.

A deposit of \$698 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the seat reduction date of August 24, 2026 are based upon availability. Final payment due by December 11, 2026. Deposits are refundable up until August 31, 2026.
