Day 1: Thursday, January 21, 2027 Overnight Flight Step back in time and explore thousands of years of history, legend, and lore as you walk amongst Egypt's timeless wonders.

Day 2: Friday, January 22, 2027 Cairo, Egypt Today, arrive in Cairo, a modern megalopolis with an intriguing past. As arrival times will vary, there are no scheduled activities today, allowing you to settle in at your own pace and taking time to adjust to the new time zone.

Day 3: Saturday, January 23, 2027 Cairo - Grand Egyptian Museum This morning, step into the world of ancient pharaohs, powerful dynasties, and timeless treasures with a visit to the Grand Egyptian Museum* - Egypt's newest and most ambitious cultural landmark. The museum recently opened its doors in a soft launch, offering visitors an early look at its awe-inspiring collection. The museum is home to over 100,000 ancient artifacts, including the colossal statue of Ramses II, which welcomes guests in the soaring Grand Hall. While some galleries may still be preparing for their debut, the experience promises a captivating introduction to Egypt's rich heritage in a truly spectacular setting. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon and gather for a welcome dinner this evening. (B, D)


Day 4: Sunday, January 24, 2027 Cairo - Pyramids of Giza Be prepared for a dose of Cairo's legendary traffic as you head to Giza this morning. Fulfill a lifelong dream as you encounter the Pyramids of Giza, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and marvel at the enigmatic Great Sphinx. Pause for lunch at a local restaurant before returning to your hotel for an evening at leisure. (B, L)

Day 5: Monday, January 25, 2027 Cairo - Fly to Luxor - Board Cruise Ship Depart your hotel before dawn** for your flight to Luxor. Pause for a visit to the expansive Karnak Temple. Wander through this 4,000-year-old complex of pylons and obelisks, often of near-mythic proportions. Then, board your cruise ship for your 7-night voyage on the Nile River. After lunch on board, enjoy an afternoon at leisure to get familiarized with the ship. This evening, take in the views from the sundeck before joining your fellow travelers for your first dinner aboard. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Tuesday, January 26, 2027 Luxor - Valley of the Kings - Afternoon Sailing Venture thousands of years into the past. As the sun rises, cross the Nile for a day in ancient Thebes. Explore the Valley of the Kings,*** including the world-renowned tombs of Tutankhamun and Ramses VI. Visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut as well as the Colossi of Memnon. Return to the ship for a late lunch and settle in for views of the fertile banks of the Nile as you sail upstream towards Kom Ombo, where you'll arrive tomorrow afternoon. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Wednesday, January 27, 2027 Morning Sailing - Kom Ombo - Afternoon Sailing Linger over a relaxed breakfast and a lazy morning on board. Take in glimpses of the small farms that dot the Nile's banks, appreciating the simple, modest livings of local farmers. In a place where daily life has changed little over the centuries, stay on the lookout for water buffaloes and other farm animals dotting the landscape. Later this morning, engage in an informative talk covering Egypt from past to present. After lunch, dock in Kom Ombo and explore its unique double temple. Return to the ship bound for Aswan, the Nubian City. This afternoon, enjoy a culinary demonstration and learn about the staples of Egyptian cuisine from your chef. Later on after dinner, dress up and join the fun during a traditional galabeya party. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Thursday, January 28, 2027 Aswan Consider a full-day optional tour to Abu Simbel**** to visit the extraordinary temples of Ramses II, saved from the rising waters of Lake Nasser during the construction of the High Dam. If you decide to sleep in, enjoy a day at leisure to explore Aswan. Perhaps you'll visit the fascinating artifacts at the Nubian Archeological Museum or stroll along the Corniche, Aswan's waterfront promenade. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 9: Friday, January 29, 2027 Aswan This morning, hop on a motorboat for a ride to the sanctuary island dedicated to the goddess Isis. Philae Temple is among the architectural wonders rescued from the rising waters of the Nile during the building of the High Dam. Then, gain a different perspective on the epic construction of the dam during an up-close visit of the area, before returning to your ship for lunch. The afternoon is yours to explore more of Aswan. Perhaps you'll wander the local stores or search for spices in the local market, before regrouping for dinner aboard. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Saturday, January 30, 2027 Aswan - Afternoon Sailing This morning, board a *felucca* (wooden sailboat) for a scenic sailing. As your time in Aswan draws to a close, take in the views of the tall sand dunes on the western shore of the Nile. Your ship sets sail once again after lunch for a relaxing afternoon heading downstream towards Edfu. (*B, L, D*)

Day 11: Sunday, January 31, 2027 Edfu - Luxor Beat the heat with an early morning visit to the well-preserved Temple of Horus at Edfu. Peruse the endless carvings of scenes depicting the power and grandeur of the pharaohs. Return to the ship for your last stretch of sailing, docking in Luxor mid-afternoon. Upon arrival, visit the city's homonymous temple and walk among the mysterious human-headed sphinxes lining the ancient processional road to Karnak. After dinner on board, it's your choice! Linger aboard the ship -OR- join your guide for some time at the local souk (market), ending at a traditional café for a taste of mint tea. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Monday, February 1, 2027 Luxor - Fly to Cairo Early this morning,***** return to Cairo. Head towards the old town to enjoy some free time to shop in the world-famous bazaar of Khan el-Khalili. Peruse colorful trinkets, hand-painted crafts, polished pendants, and more. Check into your hotel in the late afternoon,

where this evening, you'll join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 13: Tuesday, February 2, 2027 Cairo - Tour Ends Your adventure in Egypt ends today. Return home with a new understanding of this mystical land. (B)

Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an onthe-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

***Valley of the Kings: Visiting the tombs requires climbing and descending multiple steep staircases and/or ramps with limited or no handrails. All tombs are underground, narrow, and enclosed, which may not be suitable for those with claustrophobia.

Extensive walking is required in the historic areas of Cairo and at all archeological sites, due to strict tour bus limits. Included sightseeing requires walking and standing on uneven terrain and sand with very few seating options (no benches). Most walking occurs in areas with no shade, requiring prolonged exposure to intense sunlight.

The included activities are not suitable for travelers using motorized scooters, wheelchairs, or walkers.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Temperatures can easily exceed 105° F (40.5° C), particularly in Luxor and Aswan.

Your tour includes many early-morning departures. To beat the crowds and enjoy cooler temperatures, expect to leave your hotel or ship between 5:30 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. when visiting the Giza Pyramids, Valley of the Kings, Edfu, or optional Abu Simbel.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by observance of religious or local holidays. During Ramadan and Eid observances (expected February 7 to March 10, 2027), some features may be reordered and meals may be held at hotels instead of restaurants/venues.

Entering the interior of the Great Pyramid is not part of the standard visit, as it requires climbing steep, narrow steps and passing through a 300-foot (100-meter) low shaft. This involves both climbing and crouching, and there are no handrails available. The experience is not recommended for individuals with claustrophobia. If you wish to add this visit (which costs an additional \$40 USD paid on site), the Tour Manager can assist you.

Photography and videography for personal use are allowed at most archaeological sites and museums with non-professional devices, but flash is usually prohibited indoors to protect artifacts. Your Tour Manager will update you on any local rules.

*The Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM) has fully opened as of November 2025.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

****The optional tour to Abu Simbel includes round-trip transportation by air-conditioned motor coach, entrance fees, and lunch at a local venue (which replaces the lunch on board the ship). Please expect to depart the ship as early as 7:00 a.m., returning around 6:30 p.m. The drive is about 4 hours each way.

Enrich your post-night stay in Cairo with a visit to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. This contemporary 5,300,000 square foot space sits in the historic neighborhood of Fustat. The museum first opened in 2017 and is home to a collection of 50,000 artifacts, tracing the Egyptian civilization from prehistoric times to today. On April 3, 2021, the world watched in awe as the Egyptian Ministry of Antiquities relocated here the Royal Mummies during the stunning Pharaohs' Golden Parade. The 22 mummies (18 kings and 4 queens) of Egypt's most important kings and queens were displayed on the streets of Cairo as they were transported from the Museum of Antiquities in Tahrir Square to their new home in the Museum of Egyptian Civilization. This large collection of royal mummies includes the likes of King Ramses II, the most famous pharaoh of the New Kingdom, and Queen Hatshepsut, who came to rule at a time when women did not become pharaohs. With the expert guidance of a local Egyptologist, enjoy a visit of this impressive museum – a perfect conclusion to your exploration of Egypt. The optional tour includes lunch in a local restaurant, is operated by a local representative, and requires travelers to have a post-night hotel stay in Cairo. Day 13: Cairo - Amman, Jordan - Petra

An early-morning transfer brings you to the airport in Cairo for your flight to Queen Alia Airport* located in the outskirts of Amman, the capital of Jordan. Upon arrival, embark on an afternoon-long bus ride through the desertic countryside towards the ancient city of Petra. Arrive in Wadi Musa, Petra's modern-day settlement, for a 2-night stay. This evening, experience the flavors of the region during dinner at a local restaurant. *Today dinner will be included*.

Day 14: Petra

Early this morning, travel the short distance from your hotel to the archeological site of Petra (UNESCO). Enjoy a full-day walking tour of this remarkable stone-carved city, one of the new Wonders of the World. This remarkable treasure of the ancient world remained "hidden" behind rugged mountains prior to its discovery in 1812, after being lost for over 500 years. Explore these breathtaking ruins, carved from sandstone by the Nabataeans, and learn about the importance of Petra to the ancient trade routes, the history of its prominence and decline, its rediscovery, and efforts at preservation. *Today breakfast will be included*.

Day 15: Petra - Madaba - Mount Nebo - Dead Sea

A full-morning transfer takes you to Madaba, the "City of Mosaics." Visit the church of St. George to see the famous 6th-century Byzantine mosaic map of the region, one of the oldest in existence. Meet the local community during a home-hosted lunch and savor traditional Jordanian hospitality as you connect with your hosts over a traditional meal. In the afternoon, pause at Mt. Nebo, where Moses saw the Promised Land and is believed to be laid to rest. In the early evening, descend to the lowest point on earth for a two-night stay at a hotel featuring direct access to the legendary Dead Sea. Arrive in the early evening and enjoy a sunset overlooking the Promised Land. Today breakfast and lunch will be included.

Day 16: Dead Sea

This morning, travel the short distance between your hotel and the Jordan River for an insightful visit of Bethany Beyond the Jordan, the UNESCO-recognized site where, according to tradition, St. John the Baptist baptized Jesus Christ. Then, take advantage of your hotel's private access to the beach and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to experience the Dead Sea's natural buoyancy. Share memories with your fellow travelers this evening over dinner at your hotel. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included*.

Day 17: Dead Sea - Extension Ends

Transfer to Queen Alia International Airport for your flight. Today breakfast will be included.

Important Tour Extension Information:

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. You can expect some longer days balanced with free time. This level is not a fit for travelers that require mobility assistance devices.

On the day of the included visit to Petra, you will depart the hotel as early as 6:30 a.m. to ensure you profit from the cooler hours of the day and reach the site ahead of larger crowds.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by observance of religious or local holidays. During Ramadan and Eid observances (expected February 7 to March 10, 2027), some features may be reordered and meals may be held at hotels instead of restaurants/venues.

Our transfers will depart from the Dead Sea hotel to Queen Alia International Airport.

Air inclusive rate is valid for travelers who have purchased our air package for the full tour, depending on the air schedule selected. Rate may vary for those who have purchased their own air.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.
